LUNCHTIME ARRANGEMENTS

REPORTING ABSENCES

If your child is sick or has a doctor's appointment and can't attend school, please inform us **before 9:00 AM** – either by phone or via the app.

This helps us stay informed quickly.

MESSAGE FROM THE SCHOOL HEALTH TEAM

Our school health team includes the youth doctor, youth nurse, and doctor's assistant. They carry out the following check-ups:

- 5-year-old screening: height, weight, vision, and hearing tests by the assistant
- 10-year-old screening: height and weight measurements by the nurse

You will be informed in advance when these checks will take place and will be asked to complete an online questionnaire. If necessary, a follow-up appointment will be scheduled.
