Lunch break at school: how does it work?

A lot of children stay at school during lunch break. This is called 'overblijven'. Lunch supervision is organised 4 days a week by the Stichting Overblijven Basisschool de Troubadour. In each group there are volunteers who accompany your child in a pleasant and responsible manner. In this leaflet you can read how we work. A couple of times a year, you will be informed by "De Broodtrommel" (The Lunch Box).

What happens when my child stays at school?

Lunch break is from 12.00 to 13.00. Children have lunch with their own classmates under supervision of 1 or 2 volunteers, depending on group size.

Groups 1 and 2 are given half an hour to eat their packed lunch. Afterwards they will play outside together. We have bicycles and other toys available for them. Groups 3 to 8 have 15 minutes to eat. We try to offer these groups a wide variety of incentives to play. The children can play football, there's a ball pole, and we have all kinds of other toys like stilts, skip ropes, etcetera.

The higher groups are allowed to play football or basketball in the adjoining park, when the weather permits, under supervision of the volunteers.

Only in bad weather the children stay in their classrooms under supervision. For these days we have crates with fun games at hand.

During lunch break, a coordinator is present every day to make sure everything runs smoothly.

What does my child eat and drink?

You should pack food and drink for your child, preferably in a lunch box and drinking bottle.

Empty drinks and other waste, such as fruit peels, are returned home to reduce the amount of waste in school. Do not pack candy.

Useful tips:

- Put your child's name on his/her backpack or bag, lunch box and drinking bottle.
- Adjust the amount of food and drinks to the needs of your child.

What are the rules?

We ask your child:

- To be polite to the supervisors and friendly to each other.
- To sit at least fifteen minutes at the table to eat together quietly.
- After eating, to put the lunch box with the trash and the bottle in their bag or backpack.
- To not leave the schoolyard during lunch break (higher groups are allowed to go to the adjoining park only under supervision of volunteers).


What if there are problems with my child's behavior during the lunch break?

Fortunately this very rarely happens, but if there are problems with your child's behavior during lunch break, your child will first get a warning by the coordinator.

There is a warning list in place. After two warnings, the parents are informed.

After a third warning, a written invitation for a talk with the coordinator and the teacher follows.

If there is no improvement after this talk, a sanction will follow by mail.



What does it cost?

There are two options:

- 30-days credit for €30,00 (€1.00 per day)
- Annual payment of €100,00 per year (€0,62 per day)

The amount for the annual payment can be paid in 1 or 2 instalments by bank payment. Credit cards are also paid by bank payment.

If your child stays at school 1 or 2 days a week, a credit card is cheaper, if it's 3 or 4 days, a half/year payment is more economical.

We try to keep the prices to a minimum. The revenues are used to remunerate the supervising adults and to purchase game materials, among other things.

How do I pay?

The **credit** cards remain at school and are signed each time by the supervisor.

When a card is almost full, your child will get a note saying that the card is almost full and you're asked to buy a new card.

The **annual payment** (payable in 2 instalments, 50 euros by 1 september 2020 and 50 euros by 1 January 2021) can be paid either by bank transfer or by payment request.

Bank transfer: to the account of the Stichting Overblijven.

NOTE: You have to transfer this amount yourself, you will not receive a payment slip.

How do I subscribe my child for staying at school at lunch time?

You can register your child by filling out a registration form, to be obtained from the teacher or the lower groups coordinator. On this form you indicate whether your child will stay at school on fixed days or occasionally. A separate form must be filled out for each child. Please hand it in to your child's teacher.

If your child is already attending the Troubadour, please submit the registration form at least 4 weeks before the start of the summer holidays, so we have enough time to process the information.

If there are any changes (e.g. what days your child stays at school, or changes in contact info) we ask you to please send an SMS to the foundation's phone number.

What do I do if I want to cancel or if I need an extra day?

1. You call or text this phone number: 06-47 37 44 58.
2. No later than 8.30 o'clock on the day itself.
3. Leave a message on the answering machine or state in the text message the name of your child, the date, and your child's group.
4. To report your child sick or better, also leave a message on the answering machine of the above-mentioned phone number, or send a text message.

If this is not done, we will charge you for the day. It is important for the safety of your child that we know exactly which children are at school on every day.

Can I become a supervisor?

The people who supervise your child in their group during lunch time are often parents of children at school. They receive a fee of €7,50 per day.

In addition, their own children stay at school free of charge on the same day.

It is not easy to find sufficient volunteers every year. So we'd like to ask you to consider becoming a supervisor.

Being a member of the supervising team gives you the opportunity to get to know your child's peers a little better.


