Did you know that children's reading performance improves tremendously if they read for 15 minutes every day? This is according to an initiative by publisher Zwijsen.

Children who read 15 minutes a day read as many as 1,146,000 words a year. Their vocabulary and (technical) reading skills grow immediately. The knowledge they gain from books also expands their world.
