## Culture on the St@rtbaan

From our cultural education programme, we have regular take part activities for the children at the St@rtbaan. We think it is important that they are inspired and can also develop creatively and artistically. A few more activities are planned for the coming period:

- **The mechanic and the girl**

The performance for groups 5 and 6 will be played by 'Wildpark'. A theatre performance with live music inspired by the silver-griffel-winning book: The Happy Island by M. Törnqvist. Using a Peugeot 205 as a set piece, you will witness the quest of a brave girl in search of the island of happiness.

The film for groups 4 will be briefly introduced, including background information on the filmmaker and writer Roald Dahl. After the film, the children will engage in discussion and then work on making their own mini animation by tinkering, colouring and especially using their creativity.
