# Final test scores

Our intermediate scores were already showing significant progress and the results of the final tests are going along the same lines and are very good!

Last school year, we scored 1.4 points higher than the national average and this year we score 4.0 points higher than the national average, reaching 538.9. On top of this, we also achieve (and exceed) our ambitions on the reference levels for reading, language care and arithmetic.

The coming together of everyone's efforts creates this result that we are proud of! We remain committed to maintaining and building on this every day.

Thank you to everyone, colleagues, parents and above all the efforts of our children.
