School hours/locations

Location Ondiep: start lessons 8.30 a.m.
Location Hart van Noord: start lessons 8.30 a.m.

It is important lessons can start on time. Therefore, students must be present at least 5 minutes before school starts. A teacher will be present on the playground for supervision 15 minutes before school starts. 5 - 10 Minutes before start the schooldoors will be opened and students walk quietly inside.

Eating and drinking

Around 10.45 a.m., the students eat fruit they bring from home. All students stay at school during lunchtime. Please provide your children with fruit (or vegetables), something to drink and a packed lunch each day. Candy and soda are not allowed.

On Tuesdays and Thursdays students are offered a hot lunch.

Between 12.00 p.m. and 01.00 p.m. students play outside and eat together in their classrooms. During lunch we offer the children a meaningful language activity.

Family Room

Our Family Room is a welcoming space where parents and carers can connect, learn, and access practical support. Here, we offer free weekly Dutch lessons, as well as opportunities to come together for coffee, workshops, and gatherings. The Family Room is also home to our giveaway cupboards, where families can access free food, clothing, toys, books, and personal care products, or donate items in good condition that they no longer need. Everyone is welcome.

Physical Education (PE)

At Taalschool Utrecht, students from group 3 and higher have PE with a gym teacher at least once a week. It is important students bring a separate bag with a shirt, shorts and sneakers. Group 1 and 2 have PE at least once a week with their own teachers. These students only need to bring a pair of sneakers. The sneakers will be kept at school.

What to do in case of illness

If a child is ill, we expect the parent or guardian to contact the school before 08.15 a.m.

This can be done via Kwieb parent app or by phone:

The teacher or director will keep in contact with the parents or guardian in order to be able to take action when the student threatens to fall behind.

Teachers fall ill as well. If this happens, we try to arrange a replacement teacher. Unfortunately, this is not always possible. In that case the students will be divided over the different groups. If there are no other options available, management can decide to send the children home. Naturally, we will contact the parents or guardians if this is the case.

Late for school

We consider it very important that students are in school on time. If a student is late, it is unpleasant for the student as well as for his/her fellow students and the teacher. Being late will be registered by the teacher.

We apply the following rules:

Your child is late for school 3 times

You will receive a letter from the teacher with an invitation for a talk.

Your child is late for school 6 times

You will receive an invitation from the teamleader for a second talk.

Your child is late for school 9 times

The teamleader will report frequent absence to the school attendance officer.

Permission for leave

For leave/travel outside the holidays/days off, permission needs to be requested. A form can be downloaded through our website (for parents > practical information).

The transfer perspective

Within 6 weeks after your child starts at Taalschool Utrecht, a transfer perspective document will be drawn up. In this document the medium- and end-term goals for your child are described.

In your child's group evaluations the teachers and school counsellors discuss this document. They will review whether the medium- and end-term goals are achieved. If not, they will draw up a plan to still meet the goals. Intensive help and

coaching will follow. Should this not lead to the desired results, the child will be reviewed by our care team and we will seek advice and assistance from our cooperating partners. Only if there are no other options available, we will adjust the transfer perspective. Obviously, we will inform parents or guardians on time.

How do we keep you updated on your child's progress?

During the first weeks your child goes to Taalschool Utrecht, you will receive an invitation from the teacher for a first meeting. There are several ways to stay up to date about your child's progress:

- Reading your child's report cards;
- Teacher-parent meetings in response to report cards;
- Meetings after school hours (by appointment and initiated by either the parents or the teacher).

Our teachers aim to produce report cards about their students twice a year and discuss these with you. When your child moves on to another school, the transfer document (UP) replaces the regular report card.

The results Taalschool Utrecht achieves together with the students are such that 85% percent of our students are ready to move on to a regular primary school after approximately a year and a half.
