## PLEASURE IN READING

### Reading aloud from toddler to adolescent

Reading aloud time is the time when you can watch, listen, talk and laugh together. This doesn't stop when children can read on their own. Children in middle and upper grades also develop their reading comprehension through reading aloud and talking about stories together. In addition to developing text comprehension, reading aloud has a positive effect on vocabulary and spelling development. It works best if you make reading aloud a regular time so that a routine develops, just like brushing teeth and eating together. Come check out the school library.
