# **Dutch Education system**



#### **Dutch Education system**

- Education is compulsory in the Netherlands between the ages of 5 and 16.
- The Dutch education system consists of 8 years of primary education, 4, 5 or 6 years of secondary education (depending on the type of school) and 2 to 6 years of higher education (depending on the type of education and the specialisation).
- Education system is supported by the government (except private schools)
- Standard curriculum is set by the Government.



### **Primary education**

- Primary education is intended for children in the age group 4 to 12 and is compulsory for children from the age of 5.
- Group 1-2; preparation curriculum
- Group 3; start of reading, writing and mathematics
- Group 4; multiplication tables and reading comprehension
- Group 5 and 6; history, geography and biology
- Group 7 and 8; preparing secondary education


#### Group 1-2

- Preperation curriculum, like a pre-school, projectwise – educational activities: role play, construction area, handcrafts, developing motoric skills
- Age 4-6
- Daily program in a group 1-2



## Follow development pupils

- Measure results;
- -small tests after each chapter
- -Cito-tests twice a year(comparing with national average)
- -reportcard on paper
- -Parental meetings
- Schooladvice for secondary school; depending on individual results, preferences, attitude and skills.
- Final Exam group 8

#### Secundary education

- At the age of 12 children go to one of the following types of secondary education:
- Preparatory vocational secondary education (<u>vmbo</u>) 4 years in duration
- Senior general secondary education (<u>havo</u>) 5 years in duration
- University preparatory education (<u>vwo</u>) 6 years in duration
- There are more and more <u>bilingual secondary</u> <u>schools</u>.

### **Higher education**

For further education after the age of 16 students can go to vocational education, or to higher education (depending on the type of diploma they obtained).

#### Admission to higher education

For access to bachelor's programs at research universities you need a VWO secondary school diploma. Students who have completed the first year at a university of applied sciences are also eligible for admission. For access to bachelor's programs at universities of applied sciences, the minimum requirement is a HAVO secondary school diploma.
