Results of our school

The school year is almost over, so a look back is in order.

As a team, we chose to keep the focus on three things this school year: behaviour, reading and arithmetic.

We saw that our results were decreasing, were not completely satisfied with school-wide agreements and compliance with them and saw that this basis was necessary for all children to achieve good learning at our school.

By supporting the same vision several study moments during the year and with the whole team (teachers and support staff), we managed to work as a unit.

You have been regularly informed about the behavioural routines (walking quietly in the corridor, moving in rows, teacher welcomes pupils at the door) that we have put in place and we see that it works.

There is peace and quiet and that is a good basis to start the day of lessons.

Several interventions in the field of reading and arithmetic subsequently bore fruit. Setting clear and achievable goals for each group and ensuring (frequent but high-quality) repetition provides a basis.

As a result, the percentage of students who show clear growth this school year rose from below 40% to over 80%.

Both students and team members have worked hard for this and it will provide a good foundation for the coming years.

Changes in the team

With 70 people, we work weekly on the education side of our Rendierhof Child Centre.

For childcare, almost 20 team members will be added.

Within such a large team, we always see a number of changes at the end of a school year. Some teachers choose another school within our Kinderstad foundation, others choose a job outside Kinderstad or completely outside education.

Last week you received the new group distribution. New teachers introduce themselves to you via the monthly letter and in almost all cases it is possible to have new colleagues present at the changeover morning to get to know the children.

On the positive side, we have filled all the places and we are starting the school year without any vacancies!

The parents and children of teachers who no longer work here have already been informed at an earlier time.

Teacher Kim of group 3 is leaving education and is looking for a new challenge outside of it.

Miss Tabitha no longer works in group 1-2 at this school but moves to Utrecht.

Miss Shakira replaced her for a longer period of time but will no longer work with us after the summer.

Miss Carlijn and **Miss Niké** exchange their upper school group for a group at a colleague school.

Mr. Benjamin came from a fellow school and returns there and

Mr. Marco chooses to fill in for schools.

Finally, Mr. Leo of music, is already going to enjoy his retirement.

A big thank you to all colleagues who have worked here for a shorter or longer period of time and wish you the best of luck in a new place!

Behavior

Dear parent(s)/guardian(s),

In the past school year, we have worked hard as a team on the spearhead 'positive behaviour'. We believe it is important to work together to ensure that Rendierhof has a safe learning environment and that our students can get the most out of themselves.

Important Rules and Routines

- *Routine start of the day*

At 8:20 a.m., each teacher is at the classroom door and all students are greeted.

At 8:30 a.m., the teacher closes the door and starts the lesson.

- *Walking in rows*

Pupils move through the school in silence and in rows together with their teacher.

- *Silence signal*

In each learning team, a joint silence sign has been agreed upon, which is used in the groups to get the attention of the entire class.

- *Routine 100%*

This routine is used after students are given an assignment. All students (100%) are expected to complete the assignment correctly.

Study moments team

The study days this school year were mainly focused on positive behaviour of both staff and pupils.

The following topics were discussed:

- Developing school routines
- Give and receive feedback.
- What is Professional Conduct?
- What is Professional Communication?
- Keeping order and setting boundaries.

Positive behaviour will also be a spearhead in the new school year. The existing rules and routines remain important from the start of the school year. In addition, we will keep you informed of the developments regarding positive behaviour.
