If the teacher would like to have a conversation with you, you will be invited.

We would like to draw your attention to the fact that these meetings are only intended to discuss your son/daughter's report.

For all other subjects, we ask you to make a separate (digital) appointment with the teacher.

### Grocery Cupboard

Dear Parents/Guardians,

More and more parents are finding their way to the grocery cupboard. We are very happy that this is the case, but we are also very happy that we can do this for you!

However, some things do not go as we would like.

For this reason, we would like to present the rules of the game to you once again.

1. The cupboard is only accessible to parents, students are not allowed to take anything out of it.
2. Take food with you within reason. We now see parents who fill up 2 large shoppers several times a week. That is not the intention. The items are for all parents in the target group, and we trust that you will not bring more than what you really need. We are not a branch of the supermarket.
3. Do you have any questions? Is there anything on it? Ask Mirjam, she might still have stuff.

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## Vacancy parent section MR

Dear parent(s), caregiver, guardian,

As MR, we would like to make it known that there is a vacancy within the MR for the parent section. We are looking for a parent, guardian and/or guardian who would like to participate as an MR member.

Are you interested in doing something for our school, K.C. Rendierhof, together with other parents and teachers? Then become the new parent member of our MR and give yourself a voice!

The MR, consisting of a representation of teachers and parents, meets on average every six to eight weeks. During these meetings, the school director is invited as a guest. The topics discussed concern matters that concern the school, policy and the quality of education. This includes the spending of funds, working conditions, safety, personnel developments, the school plan, the determination of holidays and days off, and communication and involvement with parents.

It is important to emphasize that substantive expertise is not required for parents in the MR. Involvement and interest in the school, on the other hand, are crucial. MR members have to study meeting documents, occasionally work out matters themselves and think about new developments. Meetings take place in the evenings, once every six to eight weeks.

The MR consists of 6 members, of which 3 staff members and 3 parents. Each MR member has a term of office of three years, with the possibility of standing for re-election once at the end of the term.

In addition to its regular tasks, the MR also has special powers, including the right of consent and the right of advice. The right of consent means that the competent authority needs the consent of the MR for certain decisions, while in the case of the right of advice, the competent authority is obliged to ask the MR for advice on certain matters.

Compared to the parent council, which deals with school activities, the MR focuses on the policy and organization of the school.
